SAISD (Substance and Alcohol Intervention Services for the Deaf) offers prevention education as part of its programming. The cause of substance abuse seems to boil down to either stress or boredom. It is our belief that clear information helps people make healthier choices before drugs and alcohol become a problem in their lives. People who turn to drugs or alcohol to handle a problem find they have added to their problems instead of relieving them.

Education and support are healthier ways to deal with stress. These are available to NTID students and the deaf community through SAISD. We address these issues by teaching many different approaches to the following related topics:

- Decision making through education
- Communication skills
- Conflict resolution
- Self-esteem building
- Quit smoking programs
- Stress relief
- Anger (management)
- Education about drugs and alcohol

SAISD does not just offer counseling on substance abuse to deaf users and their families; we also focus on prevention and education. Services offered are programming, counseling, intervention, referral, information and education. These are available to students, families, friends and professionals.
